Marjot Foundation Scholar Awards

The Marjot Foundation supports environmental education at the high school level. Each year the Marjot Foundation funds individuals or teams of high school students conducting scientific research projects. Projects may focus on any area of environmental research, and must be designed by the student applicant. Each Marjot Foundation award totals \$5,000, with \$1,000 going to the student(s), \$1,000 to an adult mentor, \$500 to the school's science department, and \$2,500 to cover the cost of supplies.
